Mark presented a very informative program on flying to, in, and back from the Bahama's in a light plane. Apparently most of the private flying to and from the islands is done in single engine aircraft. The closest of the Bahama's is less than 50 miles from Palm Beach, and one can be in radio and radar contact for the whole trip. Not much different than flying overland in the United States, except you need to file a VFR or IFR flight plan, you need a mode-C transponder, and each person aboard must have a current passport. Also, there is a \$25 per person departure tax from the islands. Apparently the government of the islands is very receptive to tourism, and there are quite generous incentives offered to visitors.

Our president, Russ, couldn't be present at the meeting, so the executive board will meet via phone conference to set up plans for our December Christmas meeting / dinner, which will be on the evening of December 4th at Steve and Bud's hangar at LEB. (Yes, it's heated!)
